Web-Based

This allows for accessibility and portability of records.

Seamless Integration with Provider Systems

Users have access to the oversight agency system and provider records from within the same interface. An Individual's records at the state system and in the provider accounts can be easily linked. Oversight users can also access incident reports, communications logs (T-Logs) and secure messages from provider agencies from their FirstPage.

Secure Communications

All actions performed on Therap electronic forms and records bears the electronic signature of the user. Audit trails can be tracked by administrators for all electronic documents with just a few clicks.

Automatic updates/alerts are sent to users as records are created and updated.
