

The Therap **Billing Support** has been redesigned to accommodate a broad range of billing related features. Billing support now combines three modules: Billing, Attendance and Electronic Billing.

Billing

The Billing module keeps track of billable and non-billable services given to individuals and calculates the billing amount for each of the billable services. It will help you prepare bills for the services you provide to individuals, as well as view all billing information in a summarized form of choice. Attendance

The Attendance module can be used for recording attendance of individuals in their corresponding programs. It also supports day to day data collection for the billing module. Attendance module provides a user friendly interface, update capability, provision for approval and access checking. The module also generates printable versions of attendance data (for authorized users) which you can use for official purpose. Electronic Billing

Electronic Billing has been introduced to assist the billing process for providers funded by Medicaid. You can create and send professional claims for a single or multiple individuals for one or more of their service lines. Claims are submitted under a Billing provider and sent to the state Medicaid directly. You can view the status of your claims and resubmit the rejected claims after making the necessary corrections.
