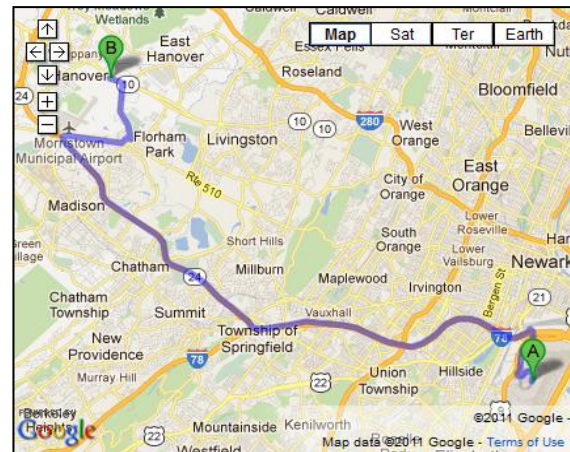


Transportation Options *for Therap National Government & Provider Administrator Conference, February 7-9, 2012*

The Ramada Conference Center in East Hanover does not have airport shuttle service, (although it has a local van that you may utilize for local trips of less than two miles), which makes getting to and from the airports and New York a little more... adventurous. Below are convenient directions for transportation to and from the Conference Center for those flying into any of the NYC area airports.

From Newark International Airport (Newark, NJ): *(Click on the map for larger view)*

Option 1) The Newark Int'l AirTrain departs from all terminals to Newark Rail Station, where you'll transfer to a NJ Transit train. The train to **Secaucus Junction Station** leaves about every 10-15 minutes (10 minute ride). At Secaucus Junction you can take the train to **Madison Station** on the Morristown line (not to be confused with Madison Square/Penn Station which will take you to NYC, you'll head toward DOVER), which departs about every hour (45-50 minute ride). Cost: **\$16.50 full/\$10.50 senior/disabled** (minus taxi fare to the Conference Center). Go to www.NJTransit.com for train departure times.



Option 2) From Terminal C, take Bus No. **GO28** toward Bloomfield Train Station. You're destination is Broad Street Station. You will arrive at **Broad St. Station** after 15 minutes, the bus stop across the street from the station, though you'll need to walk half a block north on Broad street for the cross walk (passing underneath the train tracks and I-280). Trains to **Madison** on the Morristown line (toward DOVER) leave about every hour, until the afternoon commute when they depart every 20-30 minutes (25-40 minute ride). Cost: **\$7.75 full/\$3.45 senior/disabled** (minus taxi fare to the Conference Center, also you **MUST** have exact fare for the bus (**\$1.50 full/\$0.70 senior/disabled**)). Go to www.NJTransit.com for bus and train departure times.

From Madison Station, the Ramada Conference Center in East Hanover is five miles north. There are typically lines of taxis outside of the train station. If you do need to call a taxi: **Madison Taxi** (973) 539 2500, **New Diamond Taxi & Limo** (973) 920 2595, **P & P Taxi Service** (973) 377 2693 or **All Taxi Car Service** (973) 519 3865 are local options.

From LaGuardia Airport (NYC): *(Click on the map for larger view)*

There aren't any direct trains or buses directly from LaGuardia into Manhattan, so the easiest method is by shuttle. www.goairlinkshuttle.com has a web fare of **\$15.68** from LaGuardia airport to Penn Station, www.supershuttle.com has a web fare of **\$15.00**, both have to be booked ahead of time. When putting in your information, put your destination hotel as 'Pennsylvania Hotel', which is directly opposite Penn Station. From Penn Station, head toward the NJTransit trains, you'll take the Morristown line toward DOVER, stopping at **Madison Station**. It's an hour train ride (**\$11.00 full/\$5.00 senior/disabled**). Go to www.NJTransit.com for train schedules.



From JFK Airport (NYC) : *(Click on the map for larger view)*

From JFK airport you can also use the shuttle services, the fare for www.supershuttle.com is **\$19.00** and for www.goairlinkshuttle.com is **\$18.62**. There is public transportation from JFK airport with the AirTrain linking to the **A** line at **Howard Beach/JFK Airport**. The fare for a single trip is **\$2.50** plus approximately **\$7.00** for the AirTrain. Trains depart from **Howard Beach/JFK Airport** every 5-10 minutes during rush hour, 15-20 minutes evenings/weekends and arrive at Penn Station in about 50 minutes. From Penn Station, head toward the NJTransit trains, you'll take the Morristown line toward DOVER, stopping at **Madison Station**. It's an hour train ride (**\$11.00** full/**\$5.00** senior/disabled). Go to www.NJTransit.com and www.MTA.info for train schedules for NY and NJ trains.



From Madison Station (NJT Station, Madison, NJ) : *(Click on the map for larger view)*

From Madison Station, the Ramada Conference Center in East Hanover is five miles north. There are typically lines of taxis outside of the train station.
