

Updating Individuals' Address in Therap

Background: To streamline and align data between TennCare and DIDD, DIDD's Therap implementation uses a data feed from TennCare's systems to automatically populate most demographics data for DIDD individuals supported, in Therap. This also reduces the number of locations where individuals must update their home/ mailing address data for Medicaid services. Therefore, to update individuals' addresses in Therap, the addresses must be kept up to date with TennCare (as per Medicaid requirements for services).

However, this update process requires individuals' addresses to be updated *instead* with the Social Security Administration if the individual is receiving SSI benefits. The updates trickle down to TennCare and then to DIDD's Therap system.

Summary: To change an individual supported address in Therap, the individual will need to participate in the call/data updates with either the SSA or TennCare even if there's a conservator. Ensure both residential AND mailing address are updated.

Methods for updating an address in Therap

- If the individual *DOES receive* SSI benefits, the individual must update their address with the Social Security Administration directly.
- ➤ If the individual does *NOT* receive SSI, the individual (or their family/designee) must update their own address with TennCare.
 - Individuals or their designated representatives may update their information online at the <u>TenncareConnect portal</u>
 - Information updates may also be accomplished via phone: 1-855-259-0701.
- In instances where a TennCare Partner is authorized (has presumptive eligibility), the Partner may update the individuals' address using the TennCare Access portal.
